The Wapwallopen Ministerium will hold a special service of Prayer for Christian Unity on Sunday, April 13, beginning at 3:00 pm, at Emmanuel. Pastor Leslie Halchak, New Hope UMC Charge, will preach with Rev. Penny Dollar (Emmanuel UCC), Pastor Shirley Yolton (St. Mark's UCC), Rev. Rachael Dietz (St. James Lutheran), and Rev. Phyllis Pelletier (St. Mark's Lutheran) joining in the service. The theme for this year's ecumenical celebration is "Pray without Ceasing" and reminds us that in all places and at all times God is with us, inviting us to talk with him. During this service, we will especially pray for unity for all Christians, that we will be able to continue the work of the saints who lead us to this point. One hundred years ago, in 1908, at Graymoor in Garrison, New York, the Franciscan Friars and Sisters of the Atonement held the first Church Unity Octave and have prayed for Christian unity "without ceasing" ever since. Today, Christians around the world celebrate the Week of Prayer for Christian Unity together, with the encouragement of the World Council of Churches' Faith and Order Commission and the Vatican's Pontifical Council for Promoting Christian Unity.
