This year, our youth will participate in the 30-Hour Famine beginning on March 14. Youth who want to participate can see Marc Davis for a pledge folder. Each youth has been instructed that they are not to eat after finishing their breakfast on Friday, March 14. The idea is that their friends will see them not eating lunch and ask why. This will be a way for our youth to make others aware of world hunger and the part youth can play in combating it. The 30-Hour Famine started 16 years ago as a way for junior high, high school and college-age students to help save – and change –

children's lives. By going without food for 30 hours and raising money to help needy children, young people gain a deeper awareness of the needs in our world and realize they can play a vital role in making a difference. The youth go without food but can drink plenty of water and juices so they experience true hunger and learn powerful lessons of compassion for those who live with hunger daily. We will gather in the Fellowship Hall at 6:00 pm on Friday evening. During Friday evening and Saturday morning we will play games, read Scripture, have devotions and learn about the difficulties children around the world face just trying to survive. We will also take our shopping trip during this time to purchase items for the food bank with your donations from Souper Bowl Sunday. (Think about shopping when you are hungry - how many impulse items do you add to the cart?) The youth will end their fast with lunch on Saturday at 1:00 pm and parents may pick up their children at 2:00 pm.
