- Soup sale profit needs to be announced to congregation as well as Gertrude Hawk (\$480)
- Gary accepts continued flat rate of \$500 for plowing, will buy salt at A&R on our account, needs to be added to account by Penny, last visit they would not allow him to make purchase to our account, he will provide a bill to Penny for reimbursement
- 2021 Consistory membership – Ruth and Bonnie were a maybe, will follow up to confirm
- Agreed that Penny should get \$100 amazon gift card for a holiday bonus, Lisa will buy card and send
- No further food distributions until 2021
- 2020 goal of updating church rolls, ppd until 2021 and pandemic ends to allow folks to come back safely/comfortably
- Issues with clothing bin, should see larger payment, also concern with illegal dumping, a reminder will be posted and 2021 Consistory should review after seeing next quarterly payment if the profit is worth the dumpster fees for getting rid of garbage
- Bingo – earmark profit for painting?
- Motion to approve treasurer's report Lisa, seconded by Joan – Approved
- Pastor's report – met with potential new insurance company for new estimate, gathering participants for musical prelude to 7:30 Christmas eve service
